

## PLEASE NOTE

The representative named here becomes a member of Eco-Congregation Scotland, Charity No. SC041287, representing the named church/organisation. They have full voting rights at the AGM, can nominate people to the board, and shape the vision of Eco-Congregation Scotland. Member congregations pay an annual membership fee of £50 if their annual turnover is under £100,000 and £100 if it is above this. Churches with a turnover of less than £10,000 are exempt and any church can apply to the board for an exemption if they are unable to pay.
