



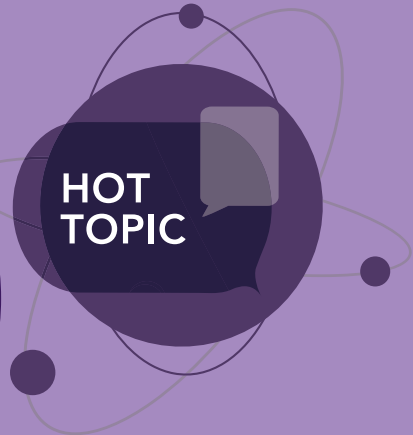
The Planet in our Hands

Responding to Climate Change

With Prof Sir Mark Walport



“The Science is clear. Human emissions are responsible for climate disruption, posing a severe threat to the planet.”



Hear Professor Sir Mark Walport, Chief Scientific Advisor to the Government, explore the subject further.

Setting out the most comprehensive evidence so far on human influence on climate change and the implications of the scientific findings, he'll talk about activities to reduce the pace of greenhouse gas induced change, how we will need to adapt to reduce impacts, and the scale and nature of the changes with which society will need to deal.

This special talk, starting 6pm on Friday 14th March includes an introduction from Heather Reid, Science Centre trustee and a science education consultant with a variety of organisations, including Learning and Teaching Scotland and SSERC.

Following Professor Walport's presentation Heather Reid will invite questions and discussion. The evening will conclude around 8.30pm.
